

SERMON QUESTIONS / SUNDAY 5th JULY
Genesis 6:9 & 22, Hebrews 11:22, Galatians 5:16-26

1. How do you think Adam & Eve, Enoch and Noah physically walked with God? (Read Genesis 6:9).
2. What does it mean to walk with God? Can a Christian not walk with God? How can you tell whether a Christian is walking with God?
3. What would you do if asked by God to undertake the enormous and crazy task of building a huge ship 500 miles away from the sea?
4. What was Noah's faith like? How would you describe it? What was the motivation behind Noah's obedience to God according to Heb.11:22?
5. What do you understand when the author of Hebrews writes: 'By faith Noah... in holy fear built an ark'? How would you define "holy fear"? In which way will "holy fear" help us to walk the walk of faith?
6. What areas do you think Christians in the West find it more difficult to "walk the talk"? (Read Galatians 5:19-21)
7. Which of the fruits of the Spirit do you find easier or more difficult to "walk the talk"? (Read Galatians 5:22-26)

The character of Christ can only be produced in us by the ministry of the Holy Spirit as we yield our new lives in Christ to the Spirit's on-going work of sanctification. Spend a few minutes reflecting and praying for the Spirit's help and strength to deal with some difficult issue in your life.
